St Paul's Church Roof Repair update

Having received permission from the diocese to proceed with the necessary work to keep the church roof and building watertight, we are now turning to all members of the church for financial support to go ahead. The overall cost is £120,000; we have saved £60,000 in anticipation and are looking for £60,000 from the congregation, either in **donations or as interest-free loans**. The plan is to repay any loans either over or at the end of 5 years; the money to repay will come from rental income for the installation of mobile phone aerials in the fleche of the church. The details of any loans and their repayment will be sorted out soon. **So far, £83,000 have been offered.** Thank you. Please make cheques payable to **St Paul's PCC** and hand them to Philip asap. **The repair work will start on Monday 12th September.** Your generosity means that we will also be able to replace the (f)ailing boiler this autumn.
