St Paul's Church Roof Repair needs your help now

Having received permission from the diocese to proceed with the necessary work to keep the church roof and building watertight, we are now turning to all members of the church for financial support to go ahead. The overall cost is £120,000; we have saved £60,000 in anticipation and are looking for £60,000 from the congregation, either in **donations or as interest-free loans**. The plan is to repay any loans either over or at the end of 5 years; the money to repay will come from rental income for the installation of mobile phone aerials in the fleche of the church.

If you are able and willing to support the PCC to begin this project as soon as possible, please let Heinz or Philip know. The details of any loans and their repayment will be sorted out after Philips return from holiday.

So far, £38,000 in loans and £ 2,600 (+GiftAid) in donations have been promised. Thank you.
